The Hillsdale County Agricultural Society is excited to announce a new fundraising opportunity. We will be selling personalized paver bricks. The bricks will be placed around the "re-purposed" Information Booth. Research on the history of that building tells us that the Judges Stand was built in 1890, which makes it 130 years old. Although harness racing was discontinued at the track, the Board still felt it was important to save the building if possible. That led to its move from the infield to the north end of the fairgrounds. It is now used as the Information Booth during fair week. The selection of that space to place the pavers will complete the look of that area, set the bricks in an area nearby what will be the new restrooms that the pavers will help pay for.
